What is Criw Celf?

An art club for that gives an opportunity for **year 5 and 6 children** who have shown talent and/or a special interest in art to develop their skills and experiences in an art gallery.



Who will lead the sessions?

The project employs professional and experienced artists who all have DBS checks to lead the sessions.

What does membership include?

Members will attend a programme of one-day master classes in the company of professional artists who specialise in various art disciplines. 6-8 days training will be held across the year on Saturdays between 11am-3.30pm at Oriel Myrddin Gallery, Carmarthen.

Each young artist will receive an art pack containing a variety of art materials. The purpose of providing these packs is to enable the children to practice their art skills at home.

A selected exhibition of the children's artwork will be staged at the end of the year.



Is there a charge?

The scheme is subsidised by the Local Authority and the Arts Council for Wales and every child will be required to pay an annual membership fee of **£35**.

Recipients of **Free School Meals** are entitled to a reduction in membership fee to support them to take part.



It is the responsibility of parents to transport their children to and from the

sessions and to provide packed lunches.

How to apply:

There are 30 places available and each primary school can nominate up to 10 pupils from year 5 and 6 who have shown a special talent and/or interest in art to become a member of Criw Celf. Individual applications from Carmarthenshire children outside of mainstream education are also welcomed.

Every child nominated will need to submit the following for assessment:

- A 2D self-portrait, created using any art material or combination of art materials. (No more than A3 sized paper)
- A drawing of the view from any window in their home, created using any art material or combination of art materials. (No more than A3 sized paper)
- A short paragraph explaining why they would like to join Criw Celf? (No more than 50 words)
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- All applications must include name, age, school and home address. Please include the form below, completed and secured to each child's application. Ensure name is written on each item for submission.

Please note: We will not be able to contact any applicants who do not provide an address! Artwork will be returned to the schools after selection.

Beth yw Criw Celf?

Pwy fydd yn arwain y sesiynau?

Mae'r clwb yn cyflogi artistiaid proffesiynol a phrofiadol a bydd pob un wedi cael gwiriad gan y Gwasanaeth Datgelu a Gwahardd i arwain y sesiynau.

Beth mae aelodaeth yn ei gynnwys?

Bydd yr aelodau'n mynd i raglen o ddsbarthiadau meistr undydd yng nghwmni artistiaid proffesiynol sy'n arbenigo mewn amrywiol feysydd celf. Bydd 6-8 diwrnod o hyfforddiant yn cael eu cynnal ar draws y flwyddyn ar ddydd Sadwrn rhwng 11am a 3.30pm yn Oriol Myrddin, Caerfyrddin.



Bydd pob artist ifanc yn derbyn pecyn celf a fydd yn cynnwys amrywiaeth o ddeunyddiau celf. Pwrpas darparu'r pecynnau hyn yw galluogi'r plant i ymarfer darlunio gartref.



Bydd arddangosfa ddethol o waith celf y plant yn cael ei llwyfannu ar ddiwedd y flwyddyn.

Oes angen talu?

Mae'r cynllun yn cael cymhorthdal gan yr Awdurdod Lleol a Chyngor Celfyddydau Cymru a bydd gofyn i bob plentyn dalu ffi aelodaeth flynyddol o **£35**.

Bydd hawl gan y rhai sy'n derbyn prydau ysgol am ddim i gael gostyngiad yn y ffi aelodaeth er mwyn eu cefnogi i gymryd rhan.

Y rhieni fydd yn gyfrifol am gludo eu plant i'r sesiynau ac adref a darparu pecyn cinio.

Sut i wneud cais:

- Hunanbortread 2D, sydd wedi'i greu gan ddefnyddio unrhyw ddeunyddiau celf neu gyfuniad o ddeunyddiau celf. (Heb fod yn fwy na phapur maint A3)
- Darlun o'r olygfa o unrhyw ffenestr yn eu cartref, sydd wedi'i greu gan ddefnyddio unrhyw ddeunyddiau celf neu gyfuniad o ddeunyddiau celf. (Heb fod yn fwy na phapur maint A3)
- Paragraff byr yn egluro pam yr hoffent ymuno â Criw Celf? (Heb fod yn fwy na 50 o eiriau)
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- Rhaid i bob cais gynnwys enw, oedran, ysgol a chyfeiriad cartref. Llenwch y ffurflen isod a'i gysylltu â chais y plentyn. Gofalwch fod yr enw wedi'i ysgrifennu ar bob eitem sydd i'w cyflwyno.
